

M O N T E C U C C O S A N G I O V E S E R I S E R V A D O C G 2 0 1 5 B Y V A G A G G I N I

An outstanding vintage for Tuscany, with very well-balanced wines in terms of aroma, fruit and tannins.

Sangiovese grapes, the name from *Sanguis Jovis* (Jupiter's blood), grown in the Montecucco area in south-central Tuscany.

Aged for 30 months in French oak *tonneaux*. Deep ruby red colour, particularly brilliant.

Typical Sangiovese nose, an intense bouquet of black currant, dark cherry, blackberry, and light spice.

Fine balance between concentration and elegance, well-structured body, light tannins, quite some oak, classic acidity and alcohol.

The wine is ready to drink, but can age eight to ten more years.
